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Treetops Pre-school will do its best to:

- Provide an environment which has been risk assessed in response to the COVID-19 infection;
- Keep to the social distancing rules as set out by the government as much as we reasonably can:
- Provide a curriculum that meets the needs of your child's well-being, mental health and academic needs;
- Contact parents if your child displays symptoms of COVID-19;
- Inform you if staff or children in your child's 'bubble' show symptoms of COVID-19 as this will mean you will all need to self-isolate for at least 14 days or until the test comes back negative;
- Communicate between home and pre-school through notices, text, email and the Facebook page.

Parents will help their child at preschool, I know and understand that:

- If my child, or anyone in my household, shows symptoms of COVID-19, I will not send them to pre-school, we will self-isolate as a family;
- If my child, or another child in the 'bubble' shows symptoms of COVID-19 at pre-school, I will collect my child immediately;
- On my way to, and when dropping my child off and picking them up, I will keep to the 2metre social distancing rules;
- When dropping off and picking up, I will strictly stick to the pre-school timings for my child;
- If my child has a temperature of 37.8C or more I will not send my child to pre-school;
- I will remind my child about the social distancing rules but accept they are difficult to follow and that my child may not always do this successfully;
- I will support and remind my child in hand washing and nose blowing;
- If I need to pass a message to the staff member at the gate, I will do this quickly and keeping the 2 metre social distancing rules;
- I need to support the Treetops staff in all their efforts to create an 'as safe as possible' environment during this crisis;
- Read all letters / messages / emails that are sent home;
- I need to inform the school immediately of any changes to emergency contact details;
- I will send a snack and drink in for my child each day;
- I will apply sun-cream before they arrive and, provide them with a hat and light-weight jacket or jumper;
- I will send two changes of clothes in for my child and these will remain at the pre-school.
